



INCENTIVE SCHEME

- 1. Any airline can claim for discounts for establishes a new route, where two previous years haven't been scheduled flights, providing continuously flights at least for three months, with flights intensity three flights per week and more:**
 - 1.1. 100% discount for landing and passenger fee for the first year of flights.
 - 1.2. 100% discount for landing and passenger fee for the second year.
 - 1.3. 75% discount for landing and 90% discount for the passenger fee for the third year.
 - 1.4. 75% discount for landing and 90% discount for the passenger fee for the fourth year.
 - 1.5. 50% discount for landing and 90% discount for the passenger fee for the fifth year.
- 2. Any airline establishing a new route, where two previous years haven't been scheduled flights, providing continuously flights at least for three months, with flights intensity three flights per week and more, can get 70% financial support for coordinated promo campaign, but no more than 15000 euro for each new flight route.**
- 3. Airline can claim following discounts for promoting non-scheduled flights:**
 - 3.1. 30% discount for landing fee and passenger fee if airline is planning four or five flights in six months.
 - 3.2. 50% discount for landing fee and passenger fee if airline is planning six or seven flights in six months.
 - 3.3. 50% discount for landing fee and 70% discount for passenger fee if airline is planning eight flights in six months.
 - 3.4. 70% discount for landing fee and 80% discount for passenger fee if airline is planning nine or more flights in six months.
- 4. Airline can claim following discounts for promoting airfreight shipment:**
 - 4.1. 30% discount for landing fee if airline is planning four or five flights in six months.
 - 4.2. 50% discount for landing fee if airline is planning to make six or seven flights in six months.
 - 4.3. 60% discount for landing fee if airline is planning to make eight flights in six months.
 - 4.4. 70% discount for landing fee if airline is planning to make nine and more flights in six months.
